All exhibits to be grown by the exhibitor in his or her own garden. Flower arrangements excepted.

All entry forms with entry fees handed into Woodchurch Hub by 4pm on Wednesday 16th July.

Fee of 50p (excluding children whose entries are free in Section F & G) for every category entry to accompany this form. Indicate how many entries per category on this form.

All exhibits to be delivered to Memorial Hall between 9 and 10am on the day of the show for display. Exhibits to be collected from 3 - 3.30pm.

Points will be awarded as follows: 5 points for a 1st prize, 3 points for a 2nd prize, 1 point for a third prize.

Woodchurch in Bloom will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any exhibits.

Pot plants, including cacti, flowering or foliage, have to have been in the owners possession for at least three months.



Exact timings for the day will be communicated in future Woodchurch Hub Newsletters.

Photographs will then be taken of the winner and their trophy/cup will to be placed after in the Jean Mealham Centre with a sign announcing the winner and the class.
